

Medicare Part D "Certificate of Creditable Coverage"

In the next week or so, employees who are eligible for Michigan Tech's health insurance plan will receive a Medicare Part D "Certificate of Creditable Coverage" disclosure form. Federal regulations require that Michigan Tech send the certificate to your home. The disclosure only applies to those employees who are age 65 and older or who have a dependent that is enrolled in Medicare.

If you meet the above conditions, you do not need to enroll in Medicare Part D since you have prescription coverage under Michigan Tech's health plan.

Those of you who do not meet the above conditions do nothing because the regulations do not apply to you.
