



Massage Therapy Claims

You will need a prescription from your doctor for massage therapy. It must state the number of sessions prescribed and the diagnosis (neck pain, shoulder pain, etc). You will need to attach the prescription every time you submit a claim. You must see an independent, licensed massage therapist who is not located in the same complex as the provider prescribing the massage therapy.

The Massage Therapy Benefit is covered under the Outpatient Short-Term Rehabilitation umbrella which includes a *combined* 60 visit maximum in a calendar year.

Please follow these guidelines when filing a claim for massage therapy:

- Complete an [Aetna Medical Request](#) claim form
- Michigan Tech's group number is 478821, include this on the claim form
- Don't forget to include your Aetna member number
- Write "Michigan Tech Massage Therapy" on the top of the claim form
- Use procedure code 97124 (15 minutes of therapy) in section 41
- Indicate the number of units (example: 4 units = 60 minutes)
- Include a copy of your prescription and receipt of payment from provider
